In its absence, we've seen just how essential this facility was to our community and surrounding areas:

- Community events have been displaced or canceled.
- Local businesses have felt the economic impact.

Together, these contributions create a substantial starting point for rebuild efforts and position the project for future fundraising and planning stages.
